#### Content

Is the theoretical justification for the work evident?
Is the research question clearly formulated?
Are the objectives evident?
Do the hypotheses fit the statement of the problem?
Are the material and methods described in such a way that it is possible to assess and repeat the observation, experiment or analysis?
Are the results understandable?
Are the conclusions drawn from the work logical and correct?
Is the discussion limited to the essentials?
Are there no repetitions?
Can the paper be shortened?

#### **Text**

Are the sentences easy to understand?

Does the text flow well?

Have technical/foreign terms or abbreviations been explained?

Are spelling, grammar and punctuation correct?

## Layout

Is the overall layout appealing?

Do the structure and layout show a common thread?

Are the tables and figures correctly numbered and labelled?

Are the table of contents and bibliography complete?
